However, my experience at this organization has revealed that I am joined by a team of overwhelmingly kind, committed, and mission driven professionals engaged in their service to others through God. ## Shining the Light of Christ



Susanne Reynold, Director of Human Resources recently rolled out a direct support professional hiring practice of weekly hiring events held at the support center and at our Pathway programs. During these gatherings, participants have an opportunity to hear about the mission and history of Jessica & Friends Community and learn about employment opportunities available. The meetings afford supervisors and sometimes our individuals, an opportunity to assess the applicant's talents and skills to determine if we are a good match for an employment relationship. The events have proven to be fun and include lunch, snacks, prizes and good conversations between new friends.

Within the past eight weeks, J&FC has been able to add twenty-one additional employees to our staff roster. This represents a 100% increase over the number of hires for the same period last year. The larger and constantly growing workforce will enable J&FC to provide quality services to those underserved since the start of the pandemic as well as meet the staffing needs of new friends who are interested in our support.
