

- Seeing the desert oasis and caves where King David hid from King Saul

- Sifting through archeological remains

- Retracing Jesus' path into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday
- Reading passage of scripture on the location where biblical events occurred
- Pondering the death and resurrection of Jesus through a Communion service at the Garden Tomb
- Shopping in the marketplace of Jerusalem's Old City
