
Thank you for your continued investment in the mission and vision of Jessica & Friends Community as we help others continue to navigate their way towards self-actualization.

An integral aspect of improving the quality of life for our cherished friends involves understanding their interests and providing the necessary support. Through the Community Participation Support (CPS) Services we can organize services and experiences that enable them to explore their community and engage in everyday activities.

Ty, a resident of David's House, is an exceptionally sociable and amiable individual who takes delight in meeting new people. He enthusiastically shares his passion for trains and trucks by showcasing his latest pictures of them. Among his preferred destinations is the Strasburg Railroad, a place he has visited numerous times. Many of our outings with Ty involve activities such as bowling, enjoying his favorite food—pizza—and spending time with his staff throughout the day. He finds pleasure in visiting parks for activities like swinging or

> playing basketball and frequently visits the library to use the computer for searching and printing the newest train pictures. Ty meticulously saves these pictures in a notebook, always placing the latest one in a frame to proudly display. Additionally, he relishes shopping for train and truck-related items, be it a small model of a truck or a railroad tie.

During visits to his family, Ty eagerly assists with household chores and property tasks. At home, he finds joy in building with Legos and unwinding by watching the TV show "Gold Rush" after his eventful day. We are thankful that through our CPS Services Ty is able to pursue his dreams and live a fulfilling life.



### Home and Community Pillar

Jessica & Friends Community offers a combination of services designed to help adults who have intellectual and developmental disabilities create the lives they envision for themselves. However, Home and Community Services are the most flexible and creative of all. These service offerings are the perfect option for those who wish to live on their own in the community, or otherwise opt to stay at home with their families with professional supports in place. Designed to promote optimal independence, this program provides a combination of service options which can be delivered intermittently throughout one's week both at home and in the community.

In-Home and Community services is a skill-building service that helps participants become as independent as possible in their everyday lives. We help folks learn to cook nutritious meals, do gardening, housekeeping, and make appointments. Learning to navigate the community is probably the best activity of all. The possibilities are endless!

Companion services are all about making new friends and visiting old ones. Companions are someone to sit next to in church, or a trusted person to stay at home when one's parents are out for an evening.

Both services can be delivered on a one to one basis as well as in groups of three participants. We currently provide these services in York, Adams, Lancaster, Franklin and Fulton Counties. Jessica & Friends Community looks forward to the blessing of meeting each person where they live.
